Pawn Structure Pawn Chains: Pawns attack diagonally forward, so they can protect pieces that way If the piece that the pawn is protecting is captured, then the pawn is able to take the capturing piece right back When pawns form diagonal lines, in which each pawn back protects the next, then this is called a pawn chain (see the diagram)
